Autumn meeting

UPC - Patent Dispute Resolution inside and outside the courtroom

Thursday, November 21, 2024 at 18.15 hours

At the Mannheim Palace & online via Zoom

This year's autumn meeting of the IZG will focus on the Unified Patent Court and be held in English language. Since a little over a year, the UPC is successfully deciding patent disputes in traditional courtroom litigation. Very recently, important steps were taken towards the opening of the UPC's Patent Mediation and Arbitration Centre (PMAC) by the nomination of its director. PMAC will offer additional dispute resolution services for patent issues.

In the first part of the evening, we will hear about PMAC's new leadership's vision for the future. With seats in Lisbon and Ljubljana PMAC will offer support in the settlement of disputes relating to "classic" European patents and Unitary Patents. Since PMAC is going to have a special focus on alternative dispute resolution in patent disputes, the envisaged similarities with and differences from classical arbitral institutions will be highlighted. To this end, we will learn more about the services PMAC is bound to offer and how they can enhance the patent proceedings at the court.

The presentation of PMAC's services will be seconded by the lawyer's perspective. Here we will listen to the expectations that users of the UPC-system have with respect to the additional mediation and arbitration services offered by PMAC. We will hear what can be learned from experiences with patentrelated mediation and arbitration under the auspices of other institutions and what the expectations for PMAC are.

The second part of the evening will concentrate on the recent experiences with the first proceedings at UPC's Local Division Mannheim. The experiences of the court with the preparation and implementation of the first in-person hearings in Mannheim will be shared. Special emphasis will be placed on confidentiality requests and court-orders as well as on FRANDissues.
